Here are some facts surrounding the cost of living in Kingston, ON as of December 2023...







### Housing:

Housing costs in Kingston are 36% cheaper than in Toronto. This significant difference includes monthly rents for both furnished accommodations in expensive areas and normal areas, as well as utilities for a flat.





### Transportation:

Housing costs in Kingston are 36% cheaper than in Toronto. This significant difference includes monthly rents for both furnished accommodations in expensive areas and normal areas, as well as utilities for a flat.









### Groceries:

Groceries in Kingston are approximately 26% cheaper than in Toronto. For example, items like a basic lunchtime menu in the business district, a combo meal in a fast food restaurant, and a litre of whole fat milk are notably less expensive in Kingston compared to Toronto





Overall, the cost of living in Toronto is 48% more expensive than in Kingston. This substantial difference in living costs makes Kingston a more economical option, especially for students and individuals on a budget. This affordability, combined with the quality of education and life in Kingston, can be a major draw for international students choosing between different Canadian cities for their studies.

### FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

### How can I study in Canada with a scholarship?

To obtain a scholarship in Canada, aim for top grades (GPA of 3.8/4.0 or higher) and showcase leadership and commitment to your field.

Scholarships are highly competitive and favour academically exceptional students. If you need alternatives, we can guide you towards budget-friendly schools or suggest funding options that meet visa requirements.

### How much does it cost to study in Canada?

Tuition fees in Canada vary by program and province.
Undergraduate fees range from \$15,000 CAD to \$50,000 CAD annually, with higher costs for specialized programs like medicine or doctoral studies.

# May I work and study at the same time?

International students in Canada can work up to 20 hours per week during academic sessions and full-time during breaks. Jobs are available on-campus (like research or lab assistants) and off-campus (like barista or retail roles).

Working part-time helps gain practical experience and supports your studies. No separate work permit is needed, but ensure you have the right documents.
